<p>Day 1</p>	<p>MELBOURNE → PERTH → MAURITIUS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Depart Australia, transit in Perth ● Arrive in Mauritius in the evening ● Meet and greet at Mauritius International Airport by representative to escort you to your coach ● Coach transfer to hotel check in ● Dinner at accommodation <p>OVERNIGHT Sugar Beach</p>
<p>Day 2</p>	<p>SUGAR BEACH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Breakfast at accommodation ● Sightseeing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit of the Pamplemousses Botanical Garden (2 hrs) Picnic lunch in the gardens of the Demeure Saint Antoine Colonial House: <i>Welcome drink</i> <i>Basket of raw vegetables, tomatoes, cucumber, mushroom, peppers, green olives and sauce, skewers of tomatoes with Goat Cheese</i> <i>Sandwich with smoked marlin, Sandwich with Parma ham and mozzarella</i> <i>Vegetable Couscous, salad of chicken and curry with Green apples and dry grapes</i> <i>Chocolate cake & skewer of tropical fruits</i> <i>0.5 lt of water & 0.5 lt of juice</i> - Followed by a short visit of the house - Visit of the Historic Marine Ship Model Factory & Museum in Goodlands - Stop at La Citadelle (Fort Adelaide) - Walk through China Town - Stop at the Jummah Mosque (Accessible only for prayers – no visitors allowed inside) ● Dinner in local restaurant <p>OVERNIGHT Sugar Beach</p>
