Life in this rich and prosperous city was dramatically and brusquely interrupted in 79 A.D. when Vesuvius erupted and totally buried it. The city and its inhabitants were wiped out in moments. A visit to the excavations gives you a pretty good idea of what life must have been like two thousand years ago. It is also a recommended spot for a packed lunch break.</p> <p>- Naples National Archaeological Museum: Explore one of the world's best mosaic collections from Pompeii and Herculaneum.
